Statement

Alia Steel Fixing Ltd is committed to delivering high-quality steel reinforcement services that meet client specifications, project requirements, applicable standards and the expectations of principal contractors, developers and construction partners.

We recognise that the quality of our workmanship directly affects structural integrity, programme certainty, cost control and client confidence. We therefore aim to complete all works accurately, safely, efficiently and in accordance with approved drawings, specifications, method statements and site requirements.

Our approach is built around careful planning, competent supervision, skilled steel fixers and clear communication with clients and project teams. Alia Steel Fixing Ltd provides steel fixing services across commercial, residential, public sector and infrastructure projects, with a focus on precision, reliability and delivery to programme.

Commitment

The objective of this Policy is, so far as is reasonably practicable, to support the consistent delivery of work that:

- meets client and project requirements;
- complies with contractual and regulatory requirements;
- is completed to the required standard;
- uses controlled materials and workmanship;
- reduces defects, rework and waste.

Everyone working with, or on behalf of, Alia Steel Fixing Ltd must follow approved procedures, use correct information and materials, report defects or non-conformances, and support continual improvement.

Working Arrangements

We plan and manage our work to ensure that quality requirements are identified before works begin and controlled throughout the delivery process.

Where required, we review drawings, specifications, schedules, risk assessments, method statements and site instructions to ensure our teams understand the works and any project-specific requirements.

Our arrangements include:

- allocating competent and experienced personnel to each project;
- reviewing drawings, bar bending schedules and relevant project information before works commence;
- coordinating with clients, principal contractors and other trades;
- ensuring operatives understand the required sequence of work;
- checking reinforcement placement, spacing, laps, cover and fixing requirements against drawings and specifications;
- reporting discrepancies, unclear details or design concerns before proceeding where possible;
- maintaining appropriate supervision on site;
- carrying out visual checks and inspections during the works;
- correcting non-conforming work promptly;
- cooperating with client quality inspections and sign-off procedures;
- supporting project handover requirements where applicable;
- using materials supplied or approved for the project;
- protecting materials from unnecessary damage or contamination;
- following project requirements for storage, handling and installation;
- ensuring steel reinforcement is fixed securely and accurately;
- maintaining appropriate cover, spacing, laps and positioning as specified;
- cooperating with engineers, supervisors and quality inspectors;
- recording and reporting non-conformances where required;
- taking corrective action where work does not meet the required standard.

We expect all employees and subcontractors to take pride in their workmanship and to notify supervision immediately if they identify any issue that may affect quality, safety, programme or compliance.

Review

Alia Steel Fixing Ltd is committed to continually improving the quality of its workmanship, supervision and project delivery.

This policy and its supporting arrangements are reviewed regularly and updated where necessary to reflect changes in client requirements, legislation, industry standards, working practices and business activities.

We use feedback from clients, supervisors, operatives and project teams to improve our performance and prevent recurring issues. Where defects, concerns or non-conformances are identified, we aim to address them promptly and take appropriate steps to reduce the likelihood of recurrence.
